

Career Counseling and Placement

The Office of Counseling, Cooperative Education and Career Planning and Placement is to assist students in understanding their potentials and limitations as they relate to career development, to provide students the opportunities to engage in career exploration through orientation programs, dissemination data and extensive exposure to occupational and vocational information, to assist students through counseling in making career choices and to secure job placements commensurate with their educational qualifications, to serve as a clearinghouse for jobs and job information and to provide credentials for all students, to counsel and assist students who do not seek employment immediately after graduation, but who wish to enter graduate/professional schools.

Over 90% of the KSU graduates utilized the Office of Career Counseling and Placement office. 90% of them are placed in employment offered position or attended graduate school. The average salary for an entry level position for the class of 2013 was \$32,000 and over with great health benefits.

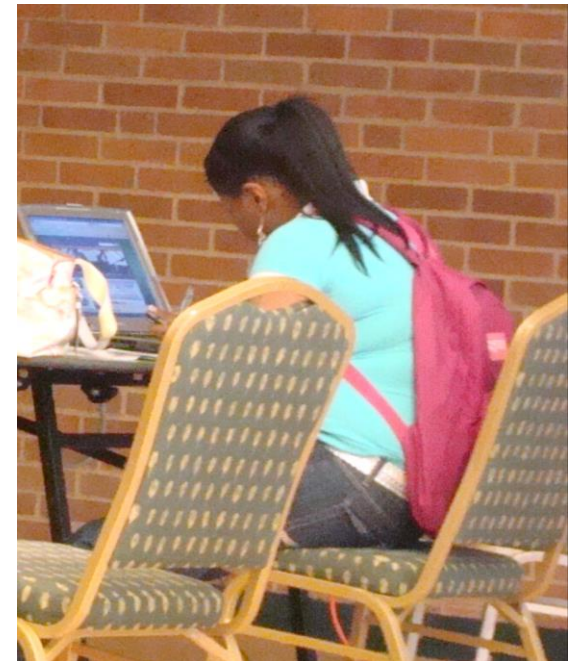

Graduating Survey

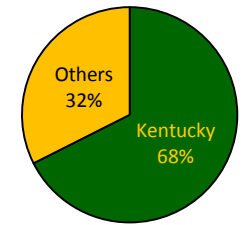

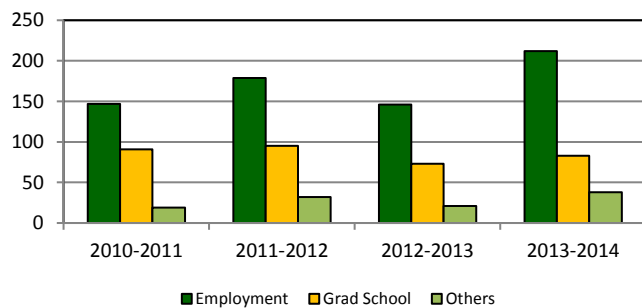
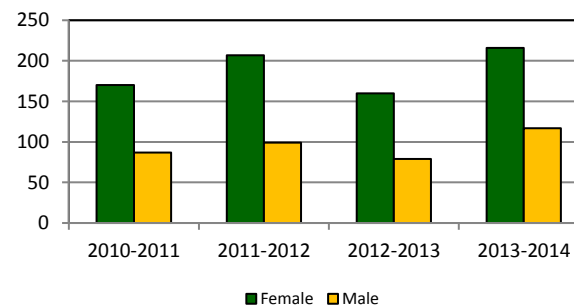
