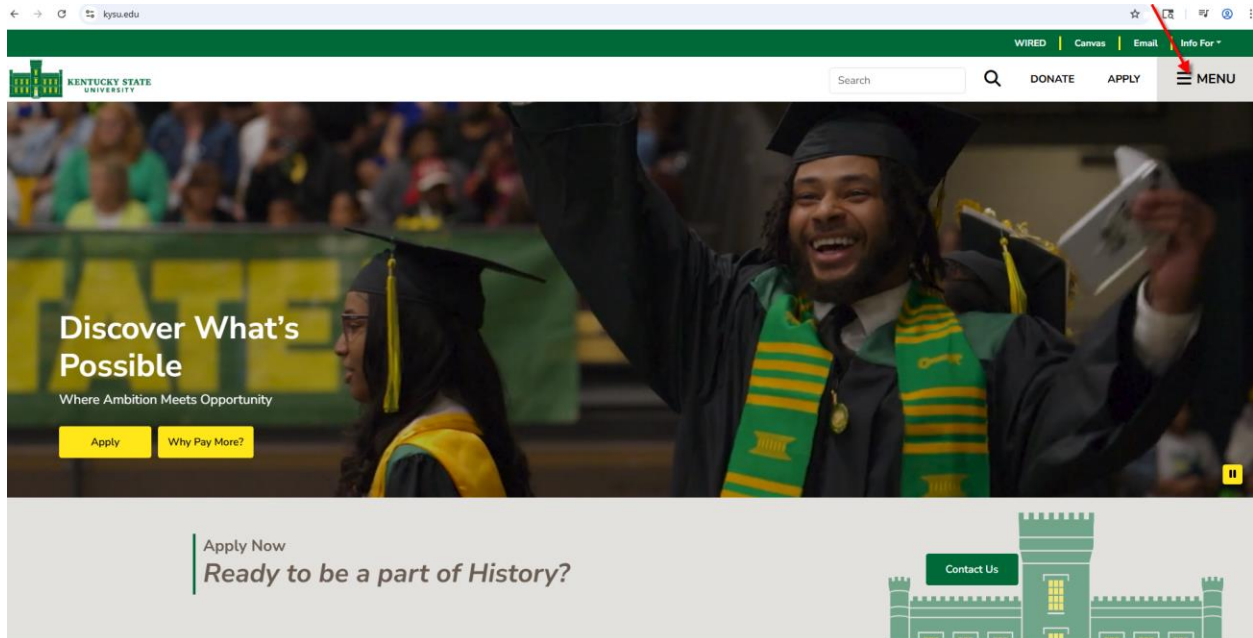
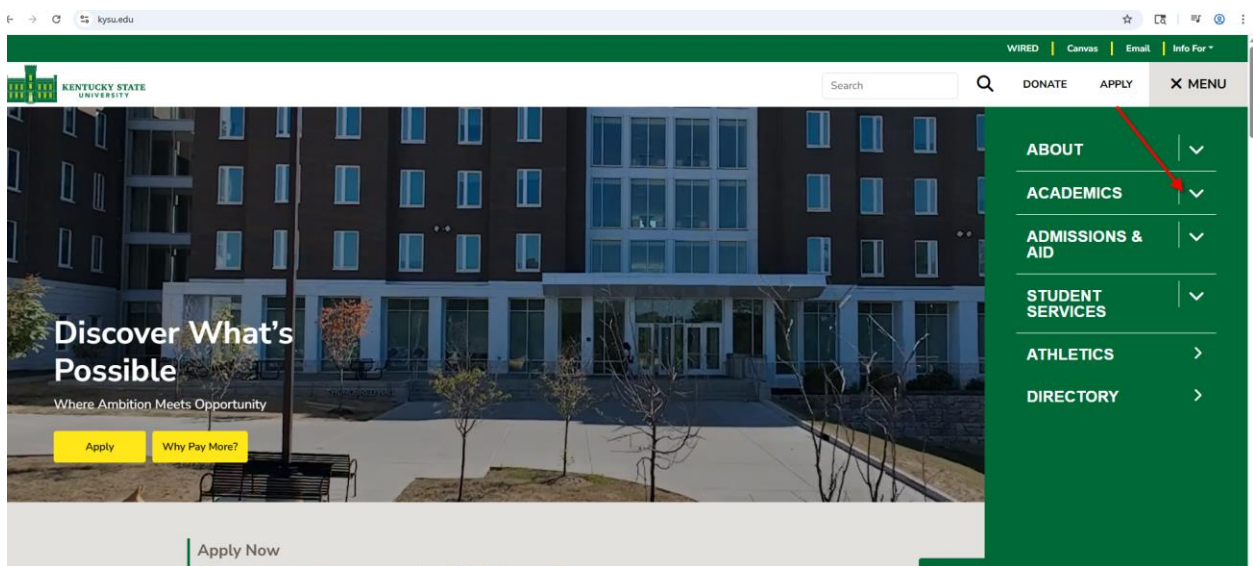


SEARCHING FOR E-BOOKS IN THE WORLDCAT DISCOVERY

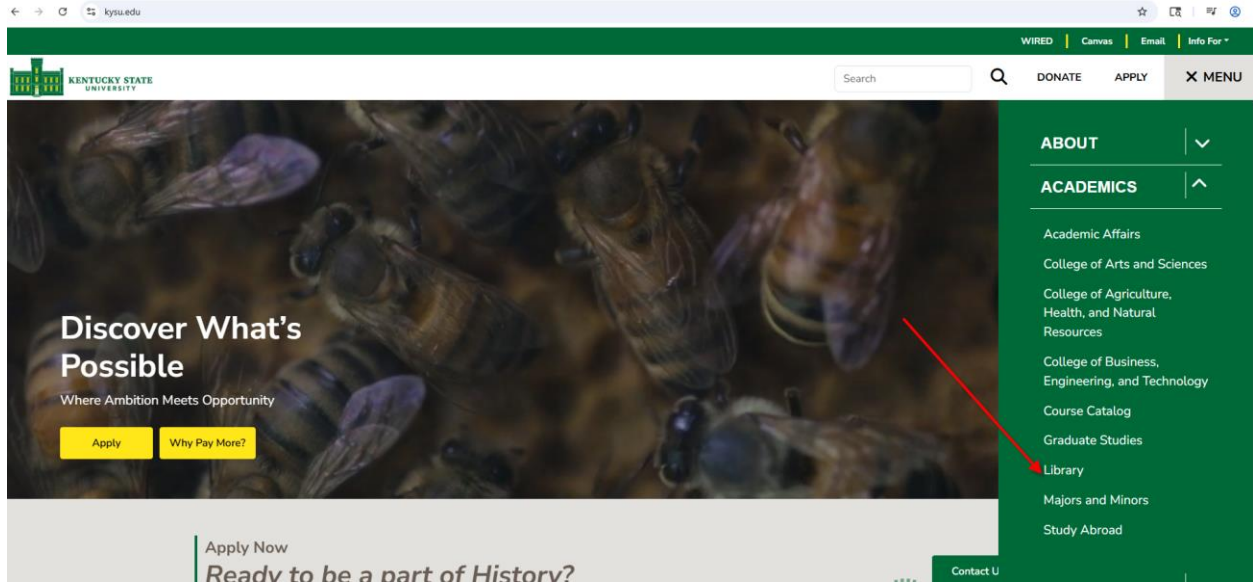
1) At KSU homepage (Kysu.edu) click on MENU as shown below:



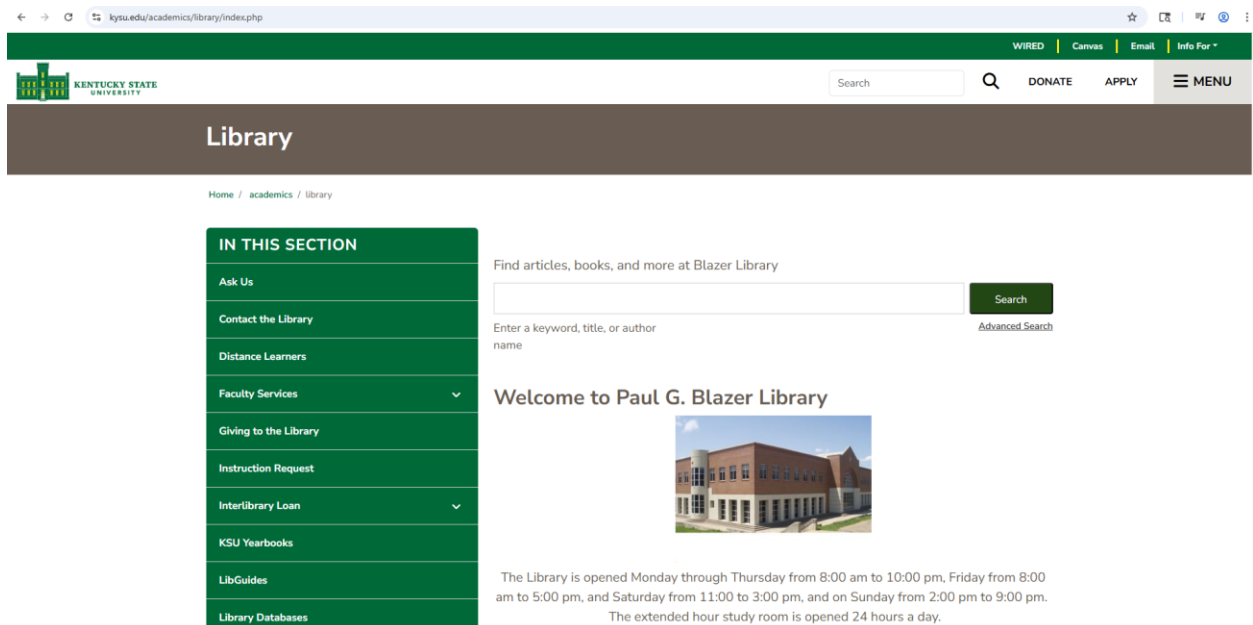
2) Click on Academics as shown:



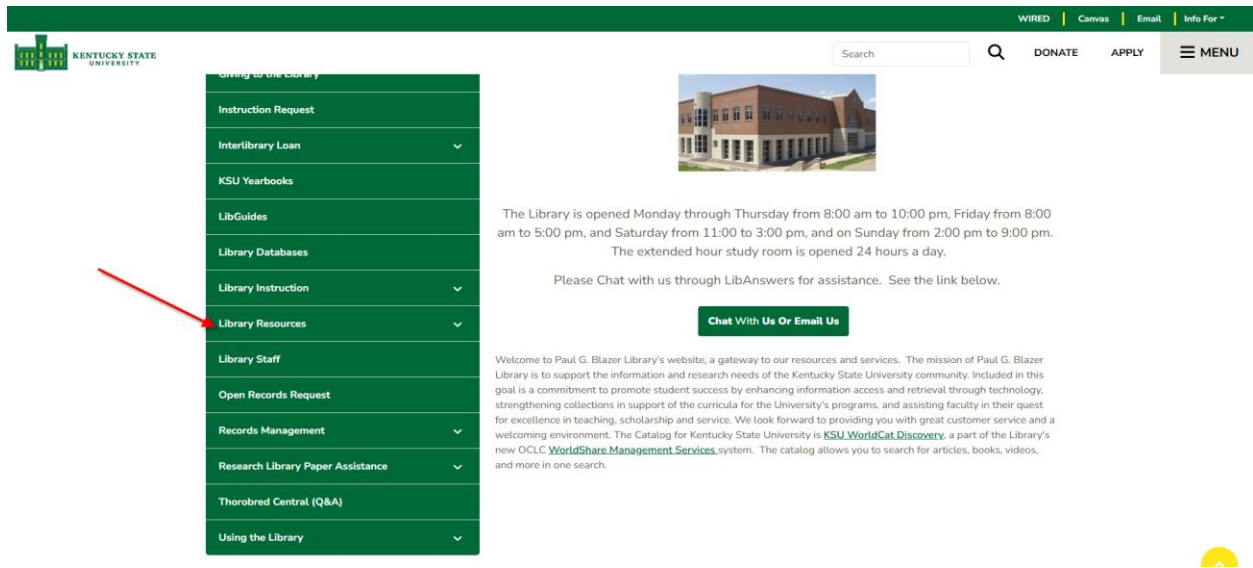
3) Click on Library



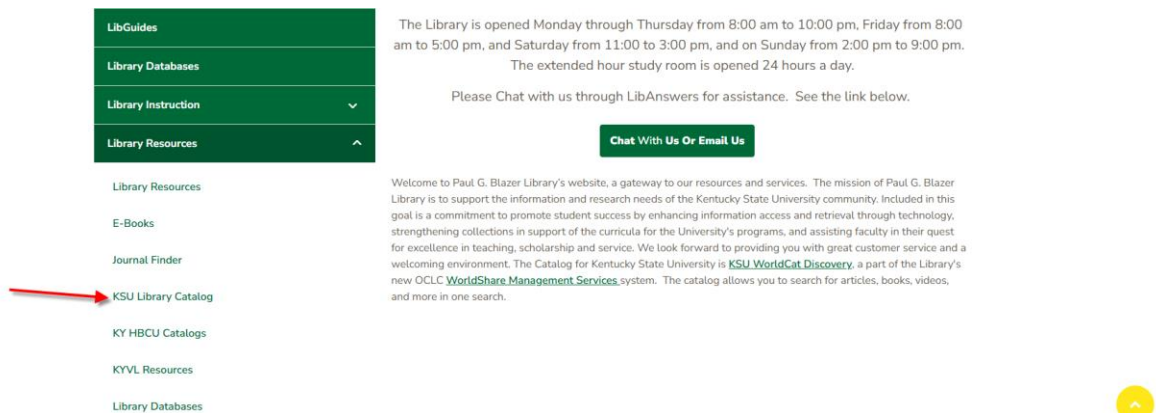

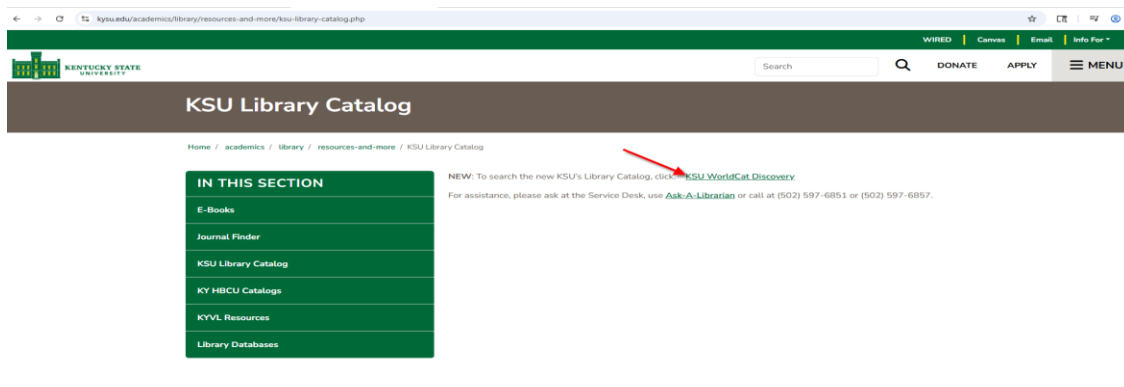
4) Click on Library Resources

At the *result list*, filter your search by clicking e-books as shown in #2 arrow at left of screen below. Next, choose a desired item by clicking on an item's "View eBook" as shown in #3 arrow below. (Note- if you prefer print books then filter to print books, copy the call number and go to the shelf to pull out the book).

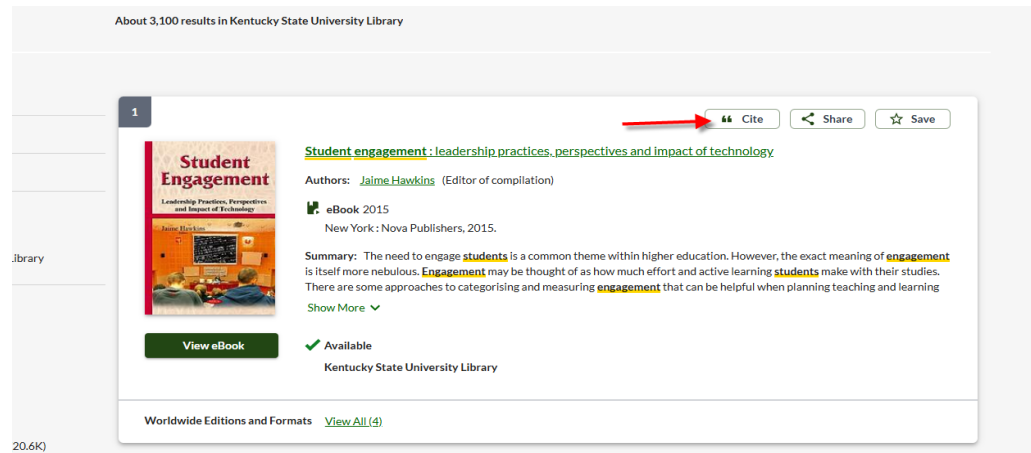
10) Here is the full text eBook. Use the tools at the top right to cite, print, listen etc. Use the page arrows at the bottom of the eBook page to navigate pages.

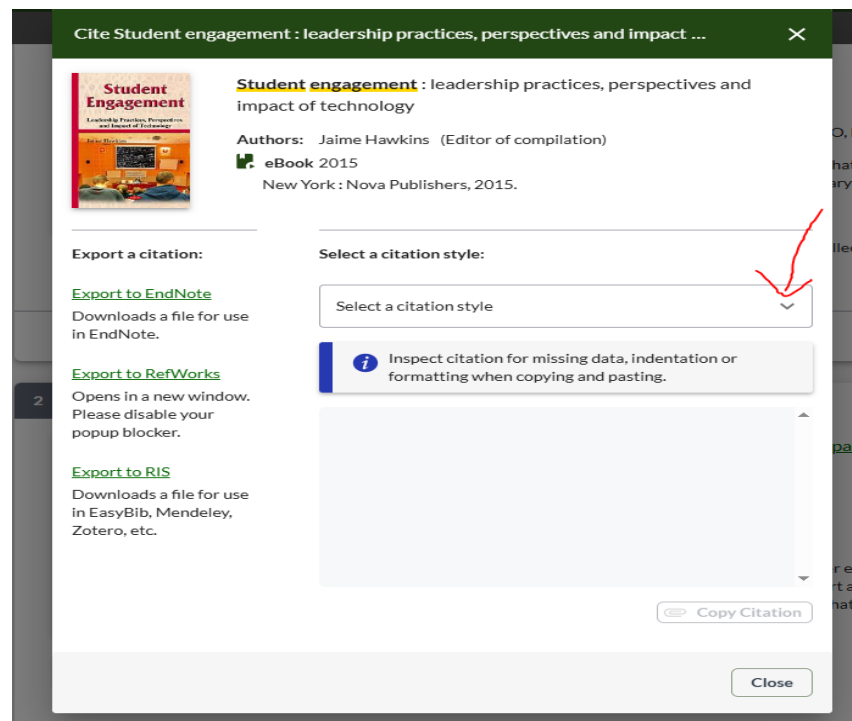
USING THE CITE, SHARE, AND SAVE BUTTONS AT THE RESULT LIST

11) Citing a single item -

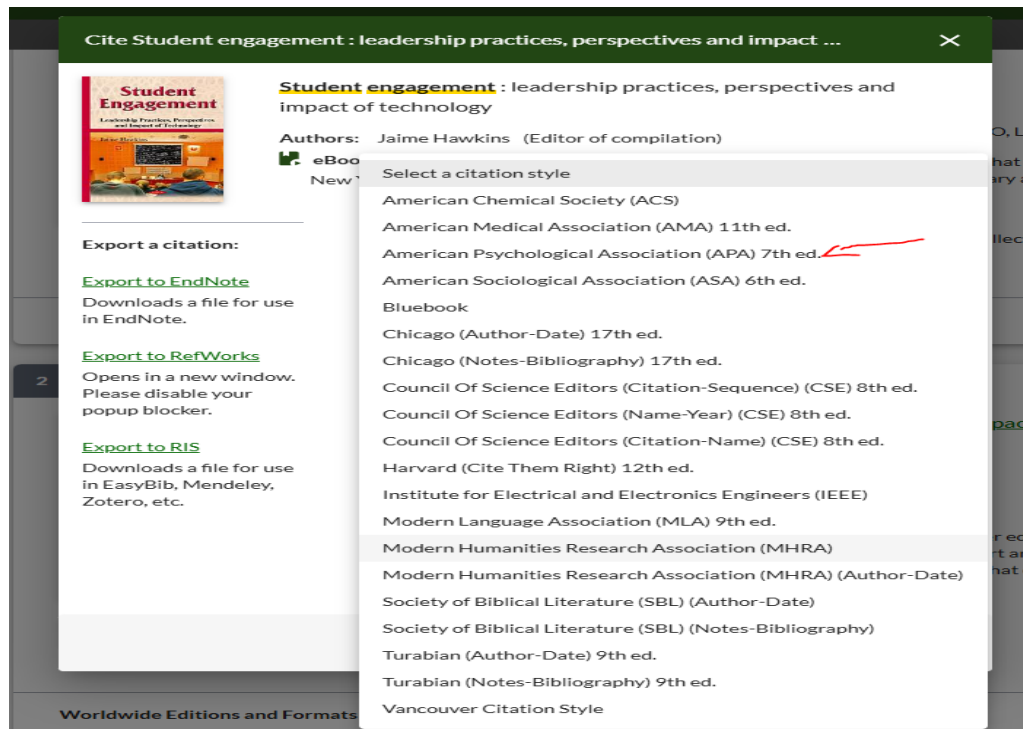
Go to the *Result List*. Click on “Cite” button as shown below:



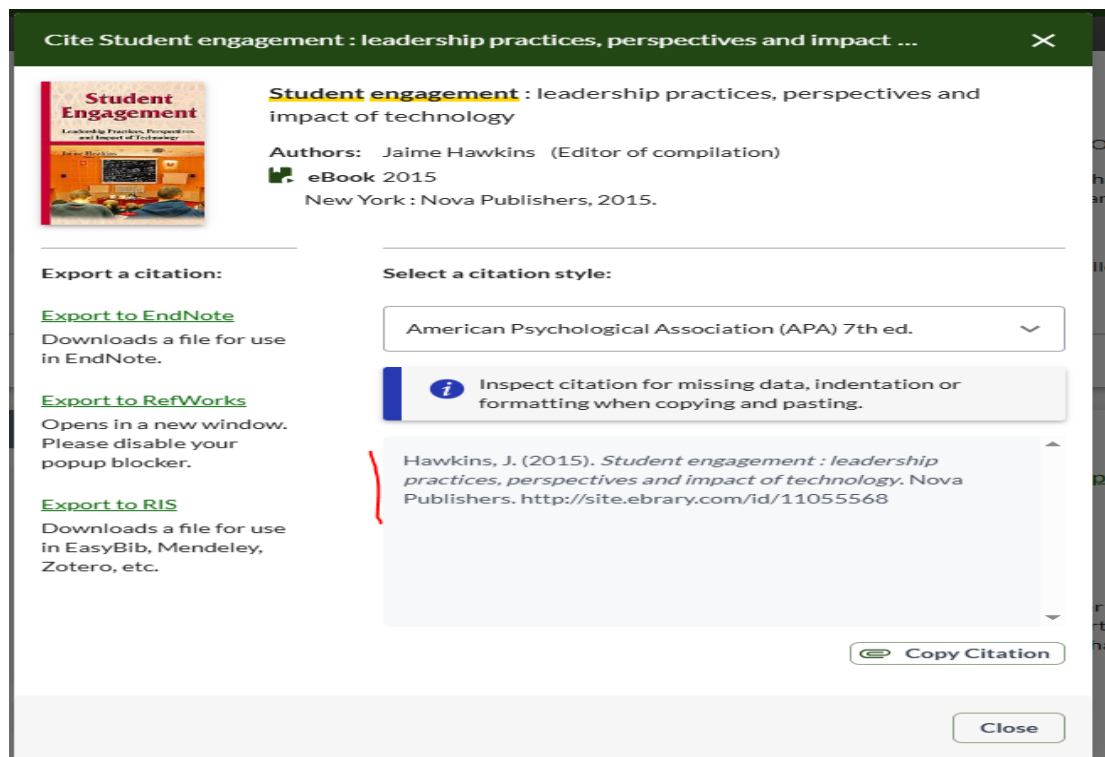
12) Select citation style.

15) To cite multiple items use the “Save” button.

At *result list* click on the save buttons of each of the item you need (Example: arrows 1 and 2). Once clicked. Look at the top right corner (#3 arrow) and click on Saved Items.

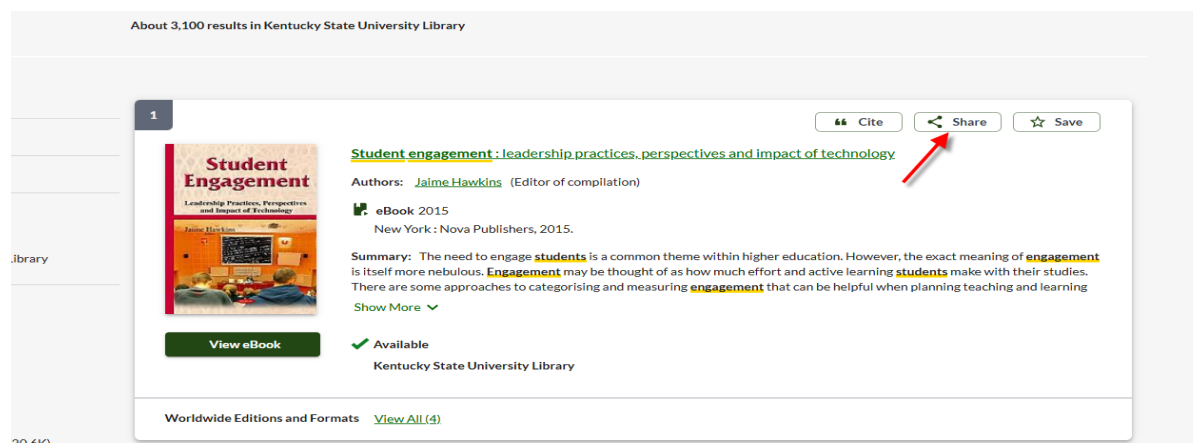

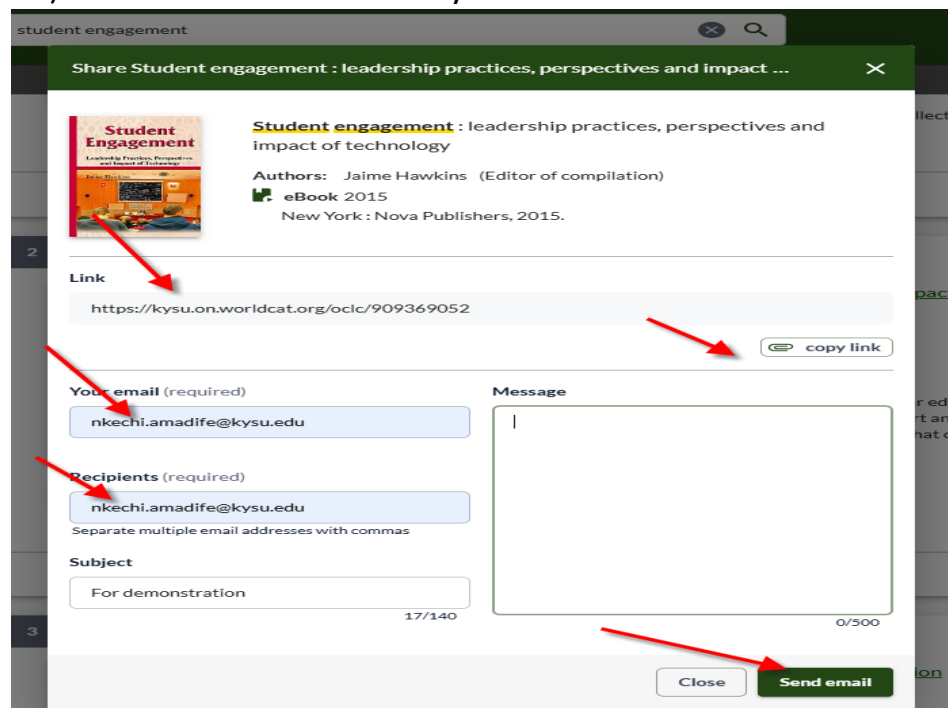
