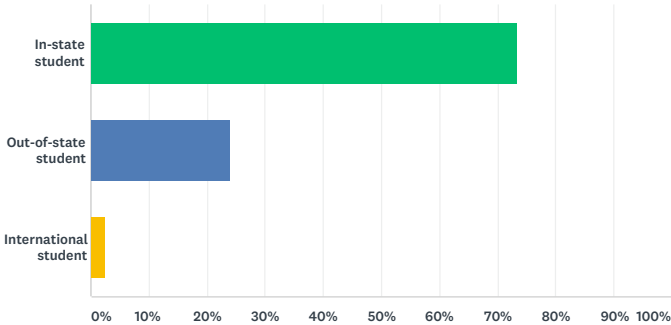

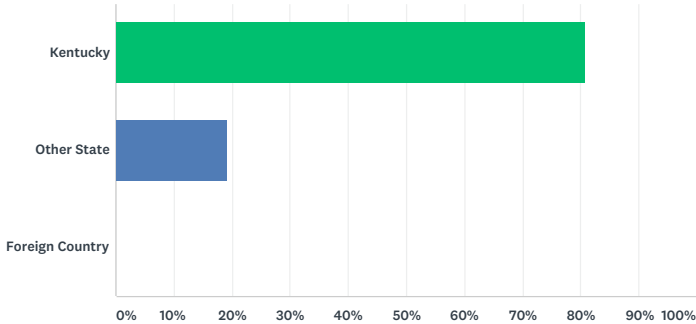

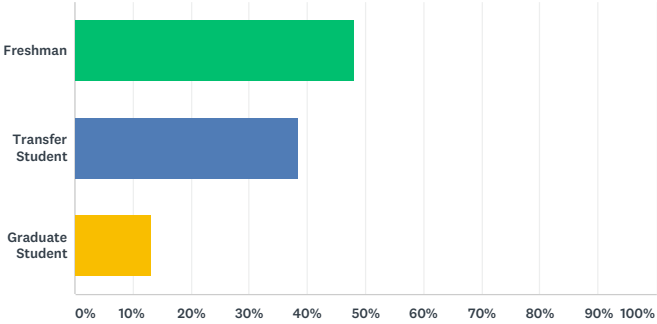

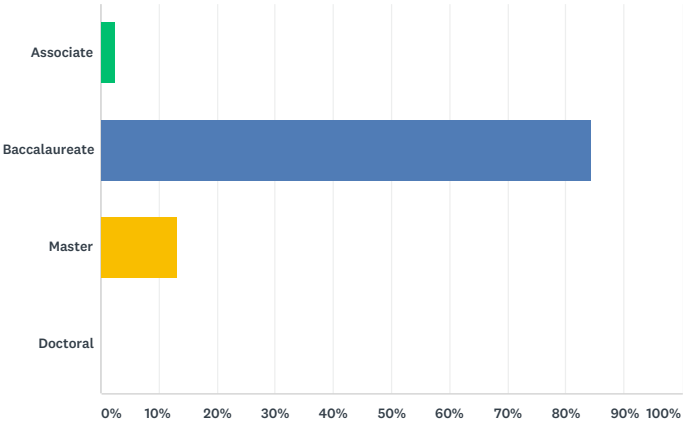

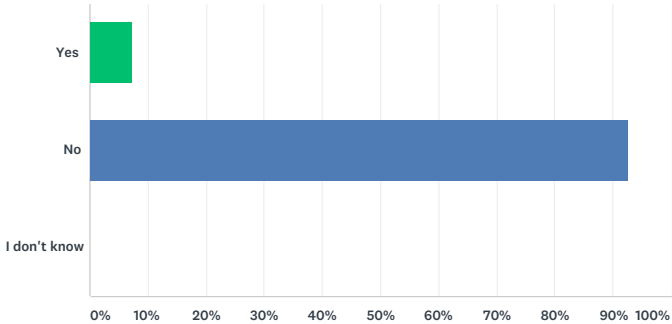

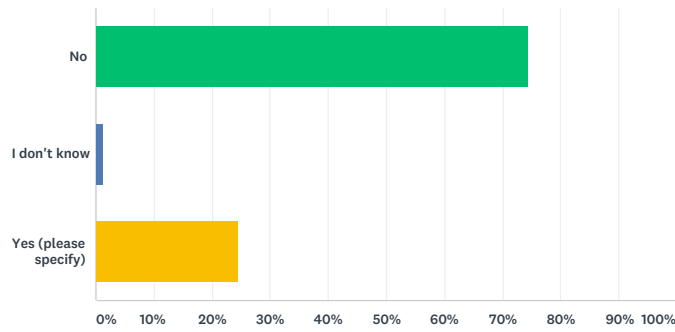

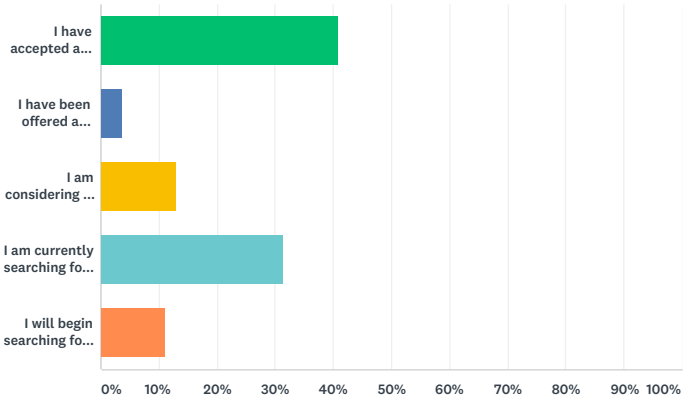

Q19 Is the degree(s) you earned in the graduating term related to this position?

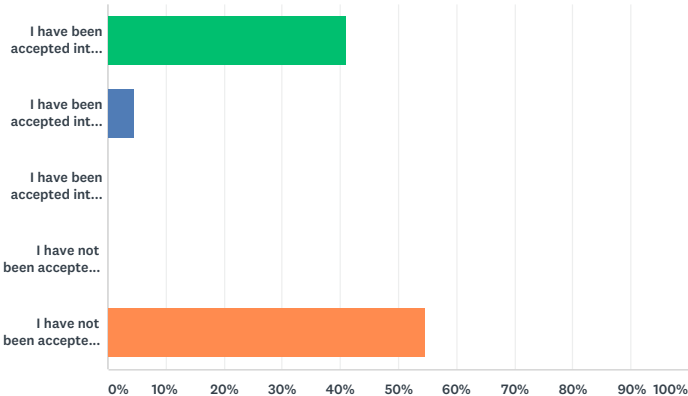

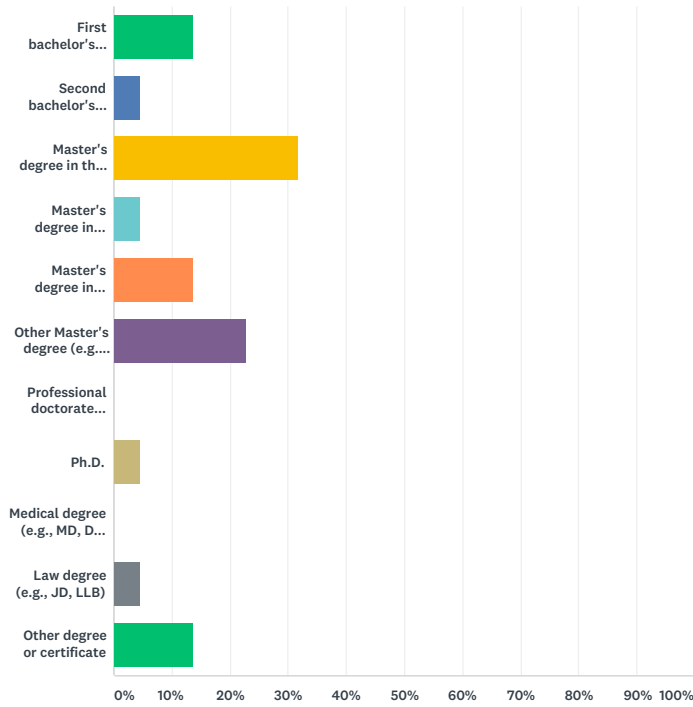

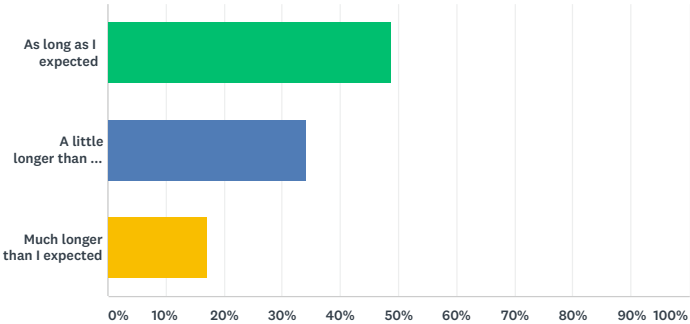

Q32 Would you continue your education at KSU?

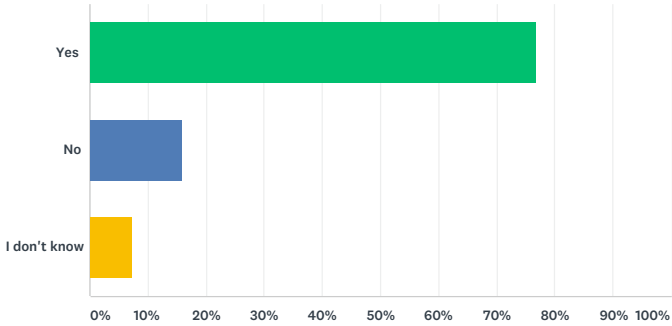

Q33 Is KSU a good value for the education that student receive?

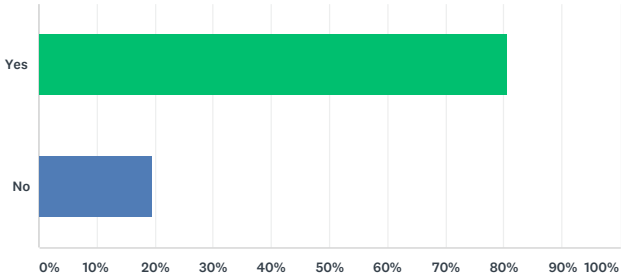

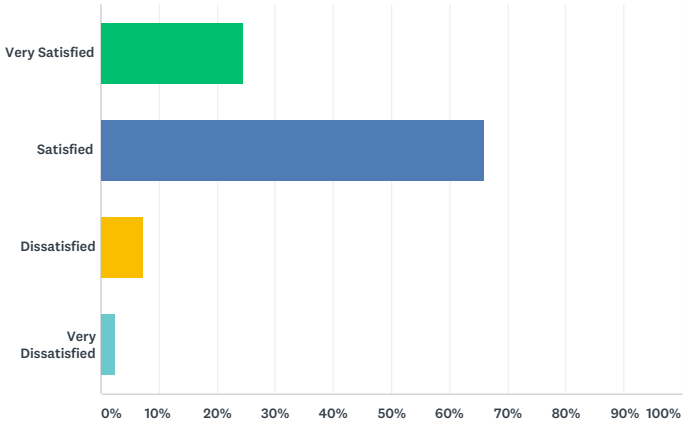
