For students, faculty and staff who wish to be tested on campus, Kentucky State will be holding testing for the campus community during safety week on Thoroughbred Tuesday, August 25, and Thoroughbred Thursday, August 27. Even though days are designated for students, faculty and staff convenience, the campus community can be tested on either Tuesday or Thursday.

Please note: On Tuesday and Thursday of this week, Kentucky State is only offering testing to individuals who are not experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g., fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, fatigue, muscle aches, or loss of sense of smell or taste).

Students who utilize Student Health Services as their primary health care provider should contact Health Services at (502) 597-6271 if you are experiencing symptoms.

Employees experiencing symptoms should quarantine and contact their health care provider, Human Resources and their supervisor.

What you need to do:

- All individuals must be symptom-free to be tested
- You will have your temperature checked and be screened for symptoms
- You must wear a mask
